NAME OF HAZARDOUS DRUG: DASATINIB;

<u>N-(2-chloro-6-methylphenyl)-2-[[6-[4-(2-hydroxyethyl)-1-piperazinyl]-2-methyl-4-pyrimidinyl]amino]-5-</u> thiazolecarboxamide; BMS 354825; Sprycel

toxic if swallowed, causes skin irritation and serious eye damage, suspected of causing cancer and damaging fertility or the unborn child, causes damage to organs {gastrointestinal} through prolonged or repeated exposure, very toxic to aquatic life with long lasting effects
