
Faculty, staff, & visitor parking located next to the Learning Center building. Student parking available after 4:45 PM

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

Can I park at Main Campus with my current parking permit?

Yes, by contacting the Montgomery Garage Office of Parking Services you can register to park at the Montgomery Garage. Add funds into your account online at Temple.edu/parking. Prior to entering the facility you must add funds onto your account so that you may park at the rate of \$10.00 per entry.

Where is the Montgomery Garage Office?

The Montgomery Garage Office of Parking Services is located at 1859 N. 11th Street, Philadelphia, PA 19122, and is open from 8:30 AM to 5:00 PM, Monday through Friday. Do I have to purchase parking if I'm parking one night per week?

All students and employees utilizing the Ambler Campus parking lots must purchase a parking permit or be subject to enforcement procedures.
